CORE ACTIVITIES OF THE LEADERSHIP ALLIANCE

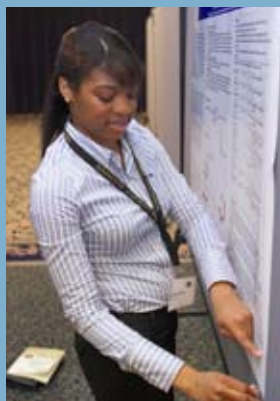
The distinctive feature of the Leadership Alliance is its core activity – mentoring across each critical transition along the academic pathway. The Summer Research Early Identification Program (SR-EIP), established in 1993, combined with the Leadership Alliance National Symposium (LANS), in 1995, is a structured program of research, networking, and mentoring that prepares young scholars from underrepresented and underserved populations for graduate training. Together, the SREIP and LANS provide an integrated exposure to research and academic careers in a supportive, mentoring environment.



OUR PROGRAMS

SUMMER RESEARCH EARLY IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM (SR-EIP)

This program introduces undergraduate students to academic careers through summer research experiences at Leadership Alliance institutions.



LEADERSHIP ALLIANCE NATIONAL SYMPOSIUM (LANS)

LANS is the national networking site and serves as the culminating event for the Leadership Alliance participants. At this weekend event, undergraduates present the results of their summer research, and attend skill

building and career enhancing workshops.

GRADUATE AND DOCTORAL ACTIVITIES

The Leadership Alliance offers workshops at LANS that encourage completion of graduate degrees and post-doctoral appointments. Networking among all participants is emphasized as a means to help scholars succeed and thrive in their careers.

MENTORS

Leadership Alliance mentors across all campuses provide a mentoring experience that guides, instructs, and assists students to reach their research and career objectives.



COORDINATORS
