

SR-EIP Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must currently be enrolled full-time in an accredited public or private college or university in the U.S. or its territories, as recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.

All applicants must:

- Be in good academic standing with a GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Demonstrate a committed interest in pursuing graduate study toward a Ph.D. or MD-Ph.D
- Have completed at least two semesters and have at least one semester remaining of their undergraduate education by the start of the summer program
- Be a U.S. citizen or have permanent resident status at the time of application

Note: SR-EIP is not designed for students pursuing professional training for careers in the practice of law, business administration, clinical medicine, clinical psychology or the allied health professions.

How to Apply

Interested students must complete the SR-EIP Online Application available at theleadershipalliance.org. The application will open on November 1, 2025.

Application requirements:

- 1. Biographical and academic information
- 2. Current resume information
- 3. Statement of purpose
- 4. Two letters of recommendation
- 5. Transcripts

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the entire application is received by February 3, 2026.
